

The Utah Division of Health requires screening students for distance visual acuity each school year. Vision screenings may take place at any point during the year. However, every attempt is made to have student vision screenings completed within 60 days from the start of the school year. School screenings are coordinated by the front office and will use trained parent volunteers and school staff to assist. School vision screenings are not a substitute for an eye examination by an eye care specialist.

Only students who fail their vision screening will receive a referral letter. However, even if your child passes, it is important your child visits an eye care specialist once a year. School vision screenings do not evaluate eye health and cannot uncover important vision problems or prescribe treatment.

You will be notified by email before the vision screening takes place to make sure your child wears their glasses or contacts at school the day of the screening. Please keep in mind Odyssey Charter School is not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken glasses.
