- 2 The coordinator works with all teachers to implement strategies in every homeroom classroom to reach a variety of learners in a variety of content areas.


While there are many aspects of giftedness, we focus on the following goals and metrics:

- 3 Challenging identified students with an engaging curriculum that includes rigor, critical thinking, creativity, depth and complexity, problem-solving, choice, and real-world applications.
